

## EMERGENCY ALERT CHECKLIST FOR FAMILY AND FRIENDS

In the event you receive an emergency alert from spidertracks about me please do the following:

1. Try to contact me on .....
2. Try to contact the following people to see if they know where I am:

3. If you receive an email alert, click on the link provided in the email to see my track.  
If you receive a text alert, please access your emails and click on the link provided or

Click on 'Tracks' and view the latest track. You may want to view the map in satellite view.
4. See whether my aircraft or vehicle is still moving. Click on the last position point and read the speed. If I'm still moving but you can't raise me on cell phone or radio, it is possible the alert has been accidentally activated.
5. If I appear to have stopped moving, you can't raise me, or if any time you are concerned about my safety, please contact the rescue coordination centre.

6. Provide the rescue coordination centre with information about my last GPS position, altitude, speed and direction and/or access to my track at [spidertracks.com](http://spidertracks.com).
